Located within a two-storey shophouse, this industrial-chic space features an exposed ceiling and white brick walls. 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ORBITAL DAGO

Opened in 2016, this contemporary art gallery showcases works by Indonesian and international artists – from paintings and sculptures to multimedia installations. It also holds artist talks, performances, screenings and art workshops for adults and children. SOUVENIR

Benne murukku is a spiral crunchy snack. Made with rice and lentil flours and generously doused in *benne* (butter), it's easily found at local grocery stores.

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BLUE TOKAI COFFEE ROASTERS, KORAMANGALA

Start the morning with an aromatic single-estate coffee in this breezy bungalow that houses a chic café and roastery. This Delhi transplant sources its beans from various coffee estates in South India. The sweet, nutty Attikan Estate medium dark roast from Karnataka lends itself well to an espresso. *bluetokaicoffee.com*

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WINDMILLS AT THE AIRPORT

Grab a craft beer as soon as you touch down at this trendy bar outside the airport's arrivals hall. There are six beers on tap, brewed in collaboration with local brewer Geist. Mango Ale, made with Indian Alphonso mangoes, remains a local favourite. *Kempegowda International Airport*



CHIANG MAI

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SOMTUM DER CHIANG MAI

The local branch of buzzy Bangkok-based Somtum Der, which received a Michelin Bib Gourmand mention in 2018, is a convivial space brightened with colourful traditional textiles. Savour classic northeastern Thai recipes like *larb pla dook yang* (spicy minced grilled catfish salad with popped rice) and grilled meats with sticky rice. *fb.com/somtumderchiangmai*



WEAVE ARTISAN SOCIETY

Housed in a former ice factory, this studio and performance space incorporates artisan dyeing and weaving workshops,

SLOW STITCH STUDIO

Tucked away in a cute studio in the city's crafty San Khampaeng suburb, this label employs Japanese stitching techniques, natural dyes and hand-loomed cottons and silks to produce one-off textiles, handbags and accessories. *slowstitchstudio.com*



TAMARIND VILLAGE

Although located in the heart of Chiang Mai's old city, this tropical oasis offers a feeling of serenity thanks to its flower-filled courtyards. The interiors feature terracotta flooring, traditional textiles and a collection of local artefacts. This artsy hotel also hosts regular exhibitions. *tamarindvillage.com*



CRU 2ND FLOOR WINE BAR

DANANG WONDERS Enjoy a day at this sprawling amusement park, which includes a monorail, roller coasters and a gigantic 115m-tall Ferris wheel. The wheel, standing at roughly the height of a 25-storey building, is one of the world's highest. *danangwonders.sunworld.vn*

PHEVA CHOCOLATIER

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Sourced from cocoa beans cultivated in southern Vietnam, these handmade chocolates are ground with vanilla beans from Madagascar and enhanced with natural cocoa butter. THAI HUA MUSEUM

Housed in a former schoolhouse, this fascinating museum offers insights into the history and culture of Phuket's Hokkien Chinese community, who arrived on the island during the tin-mining heyday of the 1800s. As a platform for budding Nepali entrepreneurs and artisans, this boutique houses a variety of homegrown brands and designs under one roof. 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JOGLO AGUNG RESTO AND GALLERY

Order beef ribs prepared in different styles - *penyet* (grilled then smashed and served with sambal) or *tongseng* (stewed with vegetables and a sweet soy sauce) at this restaurant modelled after a *joglo* (a traditional wooden Javanese house). TEVODENOI

TEKODEKO KOFFIEHUIS Housed on the second floor of a

colonial building in the Old Town, this cosy café celebrates the city's melting pot of cultures. There's Kopi Arab, spiced with cardamom, clove, ginger and cinnamon, and served with date cookies; and Kopi Gendhis, which is espresso and steamed milk with coconut sugar. fb.com/tekodekokoffiehuis

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BUDDHAGAYA WATUGONG

This Buddhist temple complex has two main buildings, both incorporating classic Chinese design and architecture. Here, you'll find a library, a Bodhi tree and the imposing Pagoda Avalokitesvara. Standing at 45m, this is the tallest pagoda in Indonesia.

KAMPUNG BATIK

You can buy batik in all shapes and forms (fabric, bags, shoes, accessories) directly from the craftspeople at this "batik village," not far from Old Town. Lessons on batik-making are also available. *Rejomulyo, East Semarang*



HOTEL CHANTI

While the rooms are a little small, guests get to enjoy a complimentary *jamu* (Javanese herbal tonic) every day and a free mini bar. The location is also hard to beat – it's right in the heart of the city's business district and is close to many attractions.

TEPPAN CHEF'S TABLE

Located on the 25th floor of Andaz Singapore, the latest addition to the luxe hotel's culinary hub serves Japanese rice bowls with gorgeous city views. The lunchtime menu offers moreish options like the Black Angus tenderloin, teriyaki chicken or miso salmon – all made-to-order. *andazsingapore.com*

Hailing from Genoa, chef Alessandro Giustetti promises guests freshly made, hand-pulled pasta at this homely new restaurant. Must-try dishes include the *lagane*, an eggless pasta with chickpeas that's said to be one of the oldest surviving pasta recipes, and the *reginette* (a type of wavy pasta) served with meat ragu, olive and pine nuts. *pastabar.sg*

Named after the original moniker for JFK International Airport, this newly opened cocktail bar at the Intercontinental Singapore is styled after the glamour of the golden age of air travel. Get cosy in a plush velvet and leather booth seat as you sip on destination-inspired concoctions. An excellent live band, playing tunes from the 1940s to 1960s, completes the experience. *idlewild.sg*

From Michelin-starred restaurant The Song of India comes this casual eatery in the heart of Little India. Take home rock tea, a type of Oolong tea grown in rocky landscapes and mainly produced in Fujian province.

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CHO'S CAFÉ & BAR

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XIAMEN SHANGLI RESERVOIR PARK

Opened in February 2019, this 47.5-hectare park is connected to the Xiamen Botanical Garden and the Meihailing Ridge, home to over 10,000 bougainvilleas. This tranquil area is ideal for a picnic or a spot of hiking.

MIIIT CAFÉ & BAR

Located on the 52nd floor of one of the most famous landmarks in the city, this trendy spot offers stunning views. Try the eponymous cocktail, which is a peach mojito topped with blue snow ice and cream. 52nd Floor, Emall Twin tower A, 180 Yanwu West Road

III SEAVIEW RESORT XIAMEN
